## Political Sign Regulations for Homeowner's Associations

## Arizona Revised Statute # 33-1808

- Unless otherwise indicated in community documents, a homeowner's association must allow the indoor or outdoor display of a political sign by an association member on that member's property subject to the following:
- Signs cannot be displayed earlier than forty-five (45) days before election day.
- Signs must be removed no later than seven (7) days after an election day.
- An association may regulate the size and number of political signs that may be placed on a member's property IF the association's regulations are no more restrictive than the City of Tucson's regulations.

## **City of Tucson Regulations**

- ✓ Do not place political elections signs in the public right-of-way or on public property.
- ✓ Do not allow election signs to obstruct the view of vehicle operators or create a traffic hazard.
- ✓ Do not post, display or otherwise attach a political election sign to or upon any street lamp post, street sign, traffic sign, hydrant, tree, fence or utility pole.
- ✓ Do not put signs or rebar into the ground with first having the area "blue-staked".
